- Discussion was held around Connecting groups eg No Jabs No Jobs, Hoody Heroes and any other groups to be brought to be linked together via Tasmanian Aware Website
- Mel was mentioned e.g. community garden and Health advice and Stand in the Park meetings
- It was mentioned Hoodys Heroes Facebook group has access to Tasmanian Aware website details via link supplied
- It was agreed that the general consensus was that the

people who we are surrounded by are all like-minded and open to solutions of how to connect

- Practical Solutions- Bug out Kit eg supplies for (3 days of survival) backpack- Action by Eammon for next meeting
- Discussion was held around bug out properties.
- Lynda offered her land of 50 acres at Tunnack for possible bug out solution. Her property which is 20 minutes South East of Oatlands at 21 Hungry Flats Road Tunnack (1<sup>st</sup> driveway on left) has organic land, bores, dams and Lynda stated she aims to be as self sufficient as possible with a community garden and will supply home and property for all to use.
- Everyone invited to bring own chairs and a plate of food to share and to meet earlier via Olde Tudor for road trip for 9.00am start on Sunday 17/7/2022.
- Digital Id was discussed re jobseeker and it was mentioned re aged pension to be next.
- Concerns were brought to attention of having food storage to prepare for food shortages like what we are already witnessing overseas and organisations were mentioned that are available and used by some already eg Red Cross, Benevolent Society, Men's sheds in Kings Meadows and Loaves and breads.
- APRHA code of conduct was mentioned regarding how its being included into contract for existing staff and the consequences involved.
- Off grid groups such as Off Grid Australia were mentioned
- Red Earth Group have systems in place for others to follow supplying invertor battery to put in trailer to support a tiny home.
- Anthony offered his expertise re Power Solution Basic Power System, Anthony offered to upload his details to website to learn skills mentioned how it can be done – batteries lithium with knowledge with electronics he spoke of the urgency for people to move

quickly regarding land and trust and constitution supporting individual freedom- **Action Anthony** upload details and skills to offer to website

- Anthony spoke about systems in place regarding freedom farmers, internal water no fuel, no gas and how to create instant power supply
